1. What questions do you seek to answer during your student teaching at Eagle Rock?
2. What makes Eagle Rock the right place for seeking answers to those questions?
3. What plan do you have for answering those questions?
4. What do you need from Eagle Rock staff and students to get answers to your questions?
5. How do you think your work here will benefit Eagle Rock? In what way will you add value to what we are trying to accomplish at Eagle Rock?
6. What specific dates are you interested in spending with us?
7. What reporting is necessary on Eagle Rock's part to your educational institution?
